

Dear Potential Customer:

Colquitt County is proud to announce that effective December 5, 2016, we will open a recycling facility in our community. This local facility is for your convenience. Anyone that would like to participate in the recycling program is encouraged to sign up with the Colquitt County Solid Waste Department today. Customers must sign up and have a current recycling account to utilize this service. Below are some key points to remember if you choose to use this facility:

- Customer must have a recycling account set up with the Colquitt County Solid Waste Department.
- Customer must set an up account in the office located in room #168 of the County Annex Building.
- An identification card will be issued to each customer.
- \$30.00 -- Use Drop Off Facility for six months (\$5.00 per month)
- \$60.00 -- Use Drop Off Facility for twelve months (\$5.00 per month)
- Customer must choose and pay for either 6 months or 12 months in advance.
- Customer may use the facility as often as needed.
- Attendant will be on site to assist customers.
- Days of operation are Monday, Wednesday, Friday & Saturday.
- Hours of operation are 10:00am – 2:00pm on M, W, F, S.
- Participation in the recycling program is not a requirement – it is only voluntary.
- **Only Household Plastic, Paper, Cardboard & Metal will be accepted.**
- **White Goods such as Washers, Dryers & Freezers are accepted as well.**

Plastic items accepted:

Household containers such as laundry detergent, bleach, as well as milk, shampoo, soda and water bottles, medicine containers, yogurt, margarine, buckets, pails, flower pots, etc. plastic pipes, shower curtains, medical tubing, furniture wrap, wrapping films, grocery bags, sandwich bags, and a variety of soft packaging materials, rigid plastics.

Paper items accepted:

Newspaper, phone books, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, cards, office paper, paper bags, soft cover books.

Metal items accepted:

Metal and tin beverage containers, food containers, aluminum foil, kitchen cookware, metal pots, pans, tools, pet food containers, bicycles, exercise bikes, small appliances, etc. Washers, dryers & freezers will also be accepted.
